



**The Ohio Program together with The Ohio State University offers a 9 month internship for students of Plant Pathology and/or Vegetable Production.**

Your internship will take place in Florida at Glades Crop Care (GCC). The Ohio Program coordinated a few dozens of internships at GCC with excellent feedback from interns.

You will learn how to identify various pests and diseases in vegetable production. After passing a test, your job will be to monitor fields and create reports. The internship is paid, the housing and transportation is arranged by the host.

**Requirements:**

- Education in plant protection and/or vegetable production or at least some college-level classes in these areas
- Very good English
- Very good driving skills and substantial driving experience
- Non-smoking

You will share housing with people from different countries and you must be open to different cultures. You must be mature and independent.

This is one of the most interesting internship placements The Ohio Program has to offer. The internship starts in September or October and lasts until May or more. Now is the time to submit application. If you qualify, please apply online:
