158 ha of pasture, 120ha irrigation, 40 - 50 ha of hay/silage and 16ha of Turnips, 8 ha Fodder Beet, 4 - 8 ha oats. 600 Jersey, Fresian and Jersey Cross Dairy Cows, 150 - 200 young dairy stock, 2 working farm dogs, 1 family dog and 1 cat. Run off property 4 kms from farm consisting of 80 ha which is used to graze young dairy stock and grow fodder crops for winter as well as making silage and hay.

Milking 600 cows under a rostered system. Milking is twice daily and each milking takes 2.5 to 3 hours including clean up. Cow flow is great and a very efficient dairy/yard facilities. Cleaning of dairy plant and yards, bringing stock to the dairy and moving to new pasture, shifting of temporary electric fences, tractor driving (cutting, stacking and feeding hay and silage, fertiliser spreading, rolling, cultivating, effluent management, shifting of K Line sprinklers in Summer mths, animal health applications of 150 -200 young stock, bull management, calf rearing, fodder crops, fencing including wallaby fence maintenance, tractor maintenance and minor repairs, weed eradication and calving down of dairy cows (August - October)
