

WESTERN AUSTRALIA

850 ha total, 200 ha bush, 450 ha pasture, 200 ha hay/silage. 1,000 Friesian dairy cattle including the milking herd of approx 320. Steers raised on property until 18 months old then sent direct to slaughter.

Milking farm duties – milking cows, animal health (drenching, needling, dehorning, castration), compliance with Dairy Assurance Program (shed cleaning/maintenance); animal mustering. Calf rearing (subject to level of skills) – completed on GEA automatic calf feeders, first 10 days manually raised, twice yearly batches of approximately 110, monitor shed daily, cleaning. General – Farm Maintenance programs fence lines and machinery, pasture assessment/paddock rotations; stock monitoring; stock feeding; harvest of hay/silage all down by ourselves (5 tractors) operating. Trainees will work on a roster system which will be given monthly.
